## Family Activity Jesus Paid for Sin

Supplies: ice cubes (one for each family member)

Give each family member an ice cube and challenge them to hold it on the inside of their wrist as long as they can. After a while the cold will start to hurt a little. Take the ice off the wrists before anyone is hurt.

**Ask:** What did it feel like after the ice was on your wrist for a long time?

This was a simple experience that was uncomfortable for a moment. Jesus suffered and died on the cross to take our punishment for sin.
