Meet the Brinsons

Trea and his bride, Cayla, have three beautiful girls, Rilynne, Raegan, and Reece, and a handsome son, River. Trea and Cayla met in Raleigh-Durham while Trea attended Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary and served as a local College and Singles Pastor. One of Trea's college students invited her friend to church...and the rest is history. The two became friends and three years later said, "I do."

Trea and Cayla moved to Valdosta, GA to start a Fellowship of Christian Athletes chapter at Valdosta State University (VSU). Trea previously served with the Baptist Campus Ministry at the University of North Carolina in Chapel Hill. Trea and Cayla have a huge passion for college students and were thrilled to move to VSU. There, they witnessed the Lord move in a mighty way as the school's FCA chapter grew to more than 300 students and athletes in its first three years. This growth led their pastor to challenge them to consider planting a church.

Less than a year later, Trea and Cayla (now with Rilynne and Raegan) surrendered to the call of planting Restoration Church in Wake Forest, NC. Restoration Church is a part of the Summit Network with two sending churches: Crosspointe Church (Valdosta, GA), and Summit Church (Raleigh-Durham, NC). For the last six years, Trea has served as the Lead Pastor and Planter. The church has seen many changes in that time: meeting locations, congregation size increases, new partnerships with domestic and international church plants, and, most importantly, transformed hearts. They have seen more than 100 people follow Jesus in believer's baptism.

Voting Process

We are walking through a new and exciting journey for our church family. God has been gracious in providing such longevity among our staff that this is the first time in more than 30 years we have needed to seek His guidance for a new Lead Pastor. The search team has been entrusted with the responsibility of leading the search process and presenting one candidate to our congregation for consideration. Over the next week we ask you as our church family to be fervent in prayer as we present Trea Brinson as our next Lead Pastor.

Next Sunday, March 22, we will introduce Trea and his family to our congregation. Because we have two campuses we will have one service at each campus on that day. Trea will preach at Eagle's Landing Griffin at 9:30am, and he will preach at the McDonough campus at 11am. Both services will end with a vote by ballot to affirm Trea as our Lead Pastor. At the end of the McDonough campus service we will compile the results of the votes from both campuses and announce the results, time permitting. Each active member of our church can vote once. Our bylaws stipulate that at least a three-fourths majority of the active members present and voting is needed to officially call a new Lead Pastor.



The Search Journey

- On October 6, 2019, Pastor Tim Dowdy met with the Leadership Team of Eagle's Landing First Baptist Church to discuss God's new call to him as Lead Strategist for Pastor Wellness at the Georgia Baptist Mission Board.
- The Leadership Team reviewed church by laws and enacted the prescribed protocol for creating a Pastor Search Committee (Search Team).
 - The bylaws state, "In the event of a vacancy in the position of Pastor, a replacement and/or fill-in shall be considered by a Pastor Search Committee consisting of the Leadership Team and five members of the Deacon Team, as elected by the Deacon Team. If the church has an executive pastor or administrative pastor, he will serve in an advisory role as an ex-officio member, without vote, of the Pastor Search Committee."
- On October 13, 2019, Pastor Tim met with the Deacon Team and informed them of his plans. The Deacon team elected five members to serve on the Search Team.
- An interim pastor was not needed as Pastor Tim agreed to continue to preach and lead the church until the new Lead Pastor answers God's call.
- Pastor Tim's new role at the Georgia Baptist Mission Board began January 1, 2020. The GBMB was gracious to give him the flexibility to remain involved with the ministry of the church while fulfilling his new duties. He could still spend time each week in the church offices and even lead staff meetings.
- On October 20, 2019, Pastor Tim informed the congregation of his intentions. The same day, the Search Team began their weekly meetings.
- The Search Team reviewed some 335 resumes from pastors in 15 states and three countries. Some candidates were personal referrals, some were submissions from state and national Baptist conventions, some were sought out by our team and some responded to job postings or our website.

- The Search Team made God's direction and guidance their primary focus from the very beginning. Much time was spent in prayer and fasting as a group and individually.
- Behind the scenes, church staff members spent approximately 75 hours building the Lead Pastor Search website, developing a system to track and monitor the progress of candidates, creating drafts of forms and documents that would be used during the process, and managing other organizational details to assist the Search Team.
- The first few meetings involved prayerful consideration and discussion about the application process, the qualifications of the Lead Pastor, roles of the Search Team, soliciting feedback from the congregation, and communication to and from the Search Team.
- One of the first decisions was to implement a time of prayer led by the Search Team every Sunday morning in the front lobby. It would be open to anyone who wanted to attend.
- The Search Team also posted a congregational survey to receive input on the Lead Pastor position. The survey was available for congregational input for two weeks. The data was collected and helped shape the search for our next lead pastor.
- After consideration of the results of the survey and internal search team discussions and prayer, the Search Team finalized the plan for the search process. The Search Team divided the tasks into subcommittees...resume team, application team, social media team, sermon team, pastoral and theological questionnaire team, and interview team. The steps are outlined on the next page.



The Application Process

STEP 1 Candidates submit their resume and short application.

STEP 2 The resume team reviews the resumes and filters the candidates.

STEP 3 Candidates submit their long application, links to sermons, and links to social media.

STEP 4 The application team reviews the application. The sermon team studies sermons, and the social media team searches through social media posts. The candidates are again filtered.

STEP 5 Candidates submit the pastoral and theological questionnaire.

STEP 6 The pastoral and theological team reviews pastoral and theological questionnaire and filters the candidates.

STEP 7 The interview team conducts the first interview with the candidate.

STEP 8 The entire Search Team discusses the interview. They evaluate the candidate and decide whether to proceed.

STEP 9 The second interview team conducts the second interview with the candidate.

STEP 10 The entire team discusses the interview. They evaluate the candidate and decide whether to proceed.

STEP 11 The entire team conducts an in-person meeting with the candidate and his wife. This is a multi-day trip. The trip will include meetings with the Search Team, Head of School, Executive Pastor, and Pastor Tim. The trip will also have a tour of the school, the Griffin campus, and the McDonough campus.

STEP 12 The entire team discusses the meeting after receiving input from the Head of School and Pastor Tim. They evaluate the candidate and decide to proceed or remove the candidate from consideration.

STEP 13 The Search Team focuses on one candidate if they feel confident that God is leading them in that direction.

STEP 14 Conduct reference checks.

STEP 15 Conduct background check, credit check, and motor vehicle record check.

STEP 16 The team verifies all reference and background checks are clear. At this point, the Search Team votes to finalize the recommendation to the church.

STEP 17 The church presents the salary and benefits package to the candidate.

STEP 18 The Search Team presents their recommendation to the church.

STEP 19 The candidate visits our campus and meets with various groups throughout the week.

STEP 20 The candidate preaches in view of a call by God.

STEP 21 The congregation votes by written ballot to affirm God's calling of the Pastor.
